E-WASTE (Electronics) should be left outside the container, as indicated by signage. E-Waste includes TV's, computers, monitors, printers, copiers, fax machines, VCR's, phones, etc.

APPLIANCES (Stoves, Washing Machines & Dryers, Refrigerators, Dehumidifiers and Air Conditioners) are accepted as scrap metal. THEY ARE MANDATED RECYCLABLE MATERIALS AND NOT ACCEPTED AT ANY TRANSFER STATION IN MORRIS COUNTY.
