### **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

### **COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Councilmember Barnett congratulated the Mountain Lakes High School Girls Soccer team for winning the Group One State Championship game and the Mountain Lakes High School Football Team for winning their sectional game. Councilmember Barnett announced that the Mountain Lakes Library will be holding a family tree research event on November 16<sup>th</sup> and a jazz trio concert on December 4<sup>th</sup> at 3pm.

Councilmember Happer announced that the Type 1 Willpower Turkey Trot will be held on November 24<sup>th</sup> and the race begins at 9am at the Mountain Lakes Club.

Councilmember Korman announced that the Mountain Lakes Club will be holding a holiday festival on December 4<sup>th</sup> from noon to 4pm.

### **SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS**

There were no presentations.

### REPORTS OF BOROUGH ESTABLISHED BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES

Recreation Commission – Recreation Director Karen Brennfleck reported that the commission recommended holding the Borough's annual tree lighting at Kaufmann Park (not at Island Beach) on December 4<sup>th</sup> and the Menorah Lighting on December 18<sup>th</sup>.

The Council discussed holding an additional holiday event at Island Beach and requested that Ms. Brennfleck discuss this with the Recreation Commission at their November 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting.

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Lucas Stelling – 66 Pollard Road, commented on Resolution 168-22 and provided additional information about the tree planting that the Shade Tree Commission will be doing on November 22<sup>nd</sup>.

### MANAGER'S REPORT

Borough Manager Stern provided his report (attached). The council asked questions of Mr. Stern and Mr. Stern answered them.

The council discussed the proposed Eagle Scout Birdhouse Mini Libraries Project and approved the project with the following conditions: Reduce the number of locations to no more than three; The location of any of the libraries cannot be at the turf field or the schools; Advise the Borough Manager as to who will monitor and maintain the mini libraries.

The council discussed the NJ Lead Service Line resident letter.

Mr. Stern advised that all of the Borough water fountains have been tested for lead and all results were negative.

The Council discussed the proposed tennis court rehabilitation project. All councilmembers, except for Councilmember Happer who abstained, agreed to move forward with the hardcourt option for the tennis court rehabilitation project. Mayor Menard spoke on behalf of Councilmember Richter who had sent an email that he was in favor of the hardcourt option. The council will finalize the specifics of the project during 2023 budget discussions. The council recommends that the Borough have a written agreement with the Mountain Lakes Board of Education regarding the tennis courts that includes use and maintenance.

Shade Tree Commission – Councilmember Korman reported that the commission is requesting that the Borough plant more trees at Island Beach.

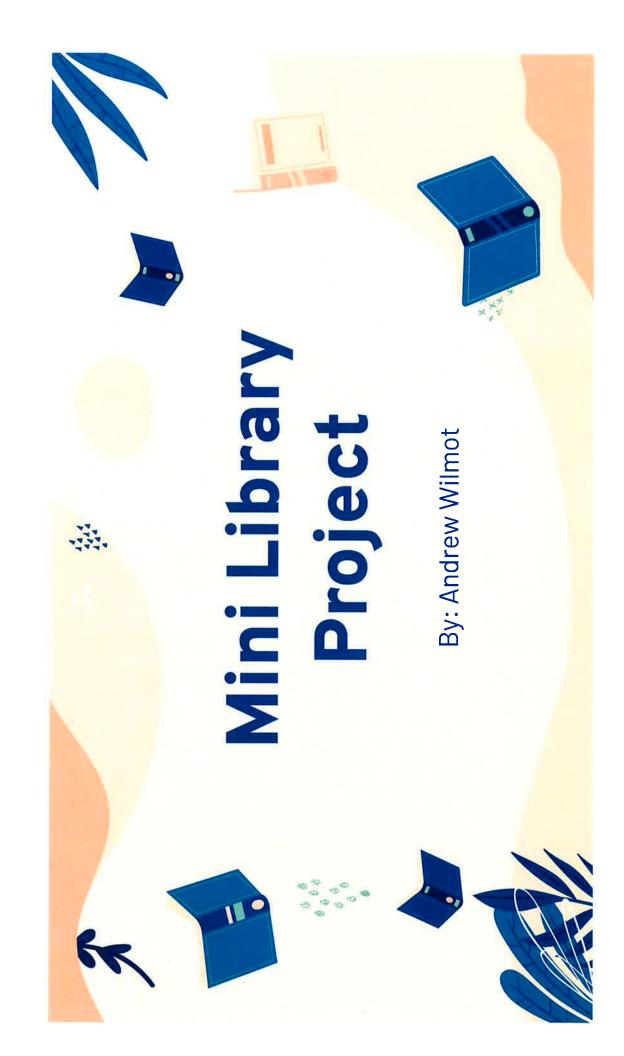
The Traffic Safety Committee has received several requests from residents to place stop signs at the following intersections:

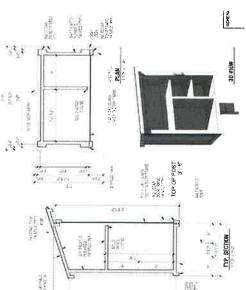

### **ORDINANCE 6-22**

"ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNTAIN LAKES AND UPDATING SECTION 229-13, "SCHEDULE IV: STOP INTERSECTIONS" BY THE INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL STOP INTERSECTIONS"

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mountain Lakes, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Mountain Lakes, Section 229-13 entitled "Schedule IV: Stop Intersections," shall be amended to include the following additional stop intersections:

Location	<u>Direction of Travel</u>	At intersection of
Ball Road	North/East	Bellvale Road
Martins Lane	East	Martins Lane
Pinewood Lane	South/East	Pinewood Lane

**Section 2.** If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

**Section 3.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
