Mountain Lakes Police Borough Council Monthly Report March 2026

- March 6, 2026, at approximately 7:46 AM, Patrolman Pierre conducted a motor vehicle stop on Crane Road, which resulted in the arrest of 52-year-old Cynthia Simon of Parsippany for an active criminal warrant out of Parsippany in the amount of \$1,000. Simon was subsequently turned over to the custody of the Parsippany Police Department.
- March 14, 2026, at approximately 10:40 PM, Sergeant Grady conducted a motor vehicle stop along Route 46 West, which resulted in the arrest of 47-year-old Cedric Martin of Jersey City for an active criminal warrant out of Jersey City in the amount of \$10,000. Martin posted the required 10% bail and was released pending a mandatory court appearance.
- March 20, 2026, at approximately 1:57 PM, Patrolman Pierre conducted a motor vehicle stop in the Wawa parking lot, which resulted in the arrest of 34-year-old Edwin Jean of Irvington for an active criminal warrant out of Long Branch in the amount of \$550. Jean was subsequently released pending a mandatory court appearance.
- March 20, 2026, at approximately 11:39 PM, patrol units responded to the parking lot of Ace Hardware on Route 46 West in Denville to assist the Denville Police Department with a reported domestic violence incident. The road-side investigation revealed that Ashani Chung had been dining earlier in the evening at Barka in Mountain Lakes. During that time, an argument occurred between Chung and her date, at which point she allegedly threw a glass cup, causing damage to restaurant property. While being taken into custody, Chung spat on a Mountain Lakes police officer and a Denville police officer on scene. Chung was charged by the Mountain Lakes Police Department with criminal mischief and was subsequently released to the Denville Police Department, who charged her with throwing bodily fluids at law enforcement officers.
- March 25, 2026, at approximately 12:43 PM, Patrolman Pierre arrested 61-year-old Neil Forde for criminal trespassing at Mountain Lakes High School.

- March 25, 2026, at approximately 11:32 PM, patrol units responded to a residence in town for a reported verbal dispute between two family members. While on scene, it was determined that 25-year-old William Waldron of Mountain Lakes had an active criminal warrant in the amount of \$1,000 out of Rockaway Township. Waldron was placed under arrest and subsequently released pending a mandatory court appearance.

A criminal complaint is merely an accusation. Despite this accusation, defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
