- Conference attendance: the director attended the NJ Recreation and Parks Association Conference in Atlantic City from February 23-25, 2025.
- Summer staffing: summer employment applications are being processed, with interviews scheduled for late March and offers going out in early April.
- Summer program registration: registration opened March 3 for Summer Recreation Camp, Teen Adventure Camp, and the Sailing Program. High demand has resulted in several sessions filling quickly. The extended day option with USA Sports Group is proving popular, with over 20 weekly participants. An additional bus has been added to Teen Adventure Week 2 to address a significant waitlist.
- Rack and ring renewal: spots opened on March 3, with over 160 renewals received out of 460+ total spots as of March 11.
- Summer program logistics: ongoing work to finalize summer program logistics and purchase necessary supplies.
- Food Truck Fest parking: alternative parking options are being researched for the July 19 Food Truck Fest, due to the unavailability of the St. Catherine's Church parking
- ML Swim and Dive Association: meetings are being held with the association to plan for the HUB Lakes Swim and Dive Championships, for which the town is the host site.
- Community events: preparations are underway for the Trout Derby and Egg Hunt, including volunteer recruitment from local high schools.
